Communication Chain for Presumptive Case or Positive Exposure:

1. Your school nurse is your first point of contact to inform the school of a possible case or exposure. (Students and Staff)

2. Your Principal or Vice-Principal is your second point of contact if the nurse is not present.

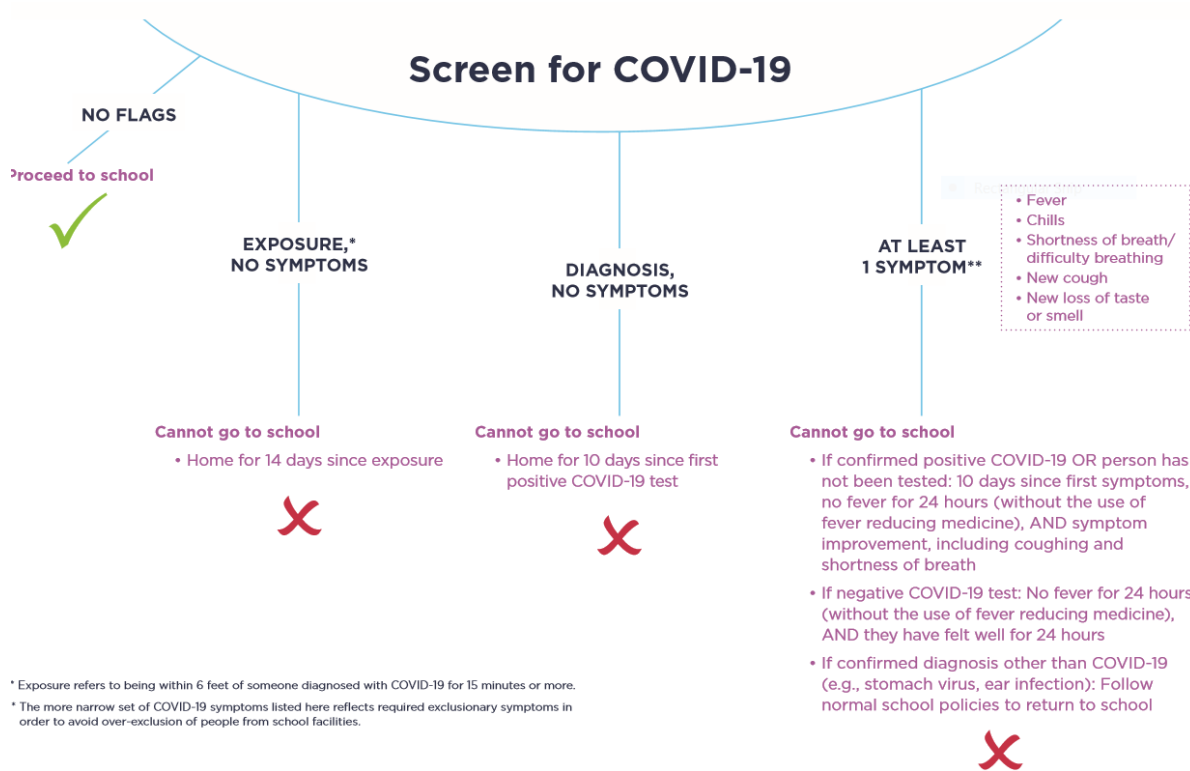

If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19, believe you have COVID-19, or have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19, please:

1. Share that they were exposed to someone with COVID-19 (defined as having close contact of less than six feet distance for more than 15 minutes) but have no symptoms;
2. Share that they were diagnosed with COVID-19 less than 10 days ago, but are NOT currently symptomatic; OR
3. Present with one of the following COVID-19 symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New cough
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea, Vomiting and Diarrhea

COVID-19 Cases and Contacts:

Student or Staff Who:

1. Presents with COVID-19 Symptoms
 - Send home
 - Recommend testing – If positive see #3, if negative see #4
 - School/classroom remains open

2. Is a close contact (closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) of someone sick with COVID-19
 - Send home
 - Quarantine for 14 days since last exposure to person sick with COVID-19
 - Recommend testing at least 4 days after last exposure (but will not shorten 14-day quarantine)
 - School/classroom remains open

3. Has a confirmed or presumed COVID-19 infection
 - Do not come to school
 - Nurse will notify the public health department
 - Isolate and exclude from school for 10 days from symptom onset or test date
 - Nurse will notify close contacts to quarantine for 14 days from last contact with sick person
 - Entire classes and teams who are in close contact may be asked to quarantine
 - Recommend testing of close contacts (but will not shorten 14-day quarantine)
 - Cleaning and disinfection of classroom and primary spaces where case spent significant time
 - School remains open. Class cohorts and teams may quarantine

4. Tests negative but is having symptoms
 - May return to school 24 hours after symptoms resolve, without use of fever-reducing medications
 - School/classroom remain open

Rancho Solano will NOT require a medical note or negative tests for the return of any student or staff that has been required to quarantine. The campus nurses will assist in monitoring symptoms and status. The Rancho Solano positive exposure policy is in effect regardless of previous diagnosis of, or exposure to, COVID-19. Rancho Solano may evaluate each case on an individual basis to determine an appropriate course of action.
